What Can I do to Help?

There are different committees within the boosters dedicated to oversight of the various areas of volunteerism. Here are those committees and what you can do to help in each one. There is no limit to how many committees you wish to join.

Public Relations Committee:

- Website development and maintenance
- Social Media page development and maintenance

- Advocacy and display of the program via school & community newspaper and radio, and any local online news source
- Photography & video of rehearsal and performance
- Advertisement
- Sponsorships within local community

Fundraising Committee:

- Coordinate the selection of fund raising events and scheduling
- Grant Writing
- Liaison will serve as Treasurer for Boosters
- Oversight of Boosters bank account
- Presenting financial report at monthly meeting (beginning fall 2019)

Uniforms Committee:

- Inventory of Marching Band Uniforms: Jackets, Pants, Hats, Shoes.
- Maintenance of Uniforms: Dry Cleaning Jackets/Pants. (Funds via District pending approval).
- Maintenance of Uniforms: Hemming/Stitching, minor repairs to fabric.
- Organization/Labeling of Uniform Parts and their respective users each school year.
- Preparing orders for fall show shirts. (Director approval/purchase-June/July).

Food/Hospitality Committee:

- Coordination of meals or snacks for students. This may include:
 - Post Concert Receptions
 - Marching Band Competition
 - Summer Band Camp
 - Football Games Home or Away
